



2 - PRIVACY

DESCRIPTION: Privacy barriers can be mitigated by updating three elements: organizational culture, policy, and FOIPPA . Existing culture, policies, and legislation are antiquated and have collectively become a barrier to the collection and sharing of data and information within government and with citizens.

ACTIONS:

1. Create an education program focused on transforming culture related to privacy and sharing of information (in progress).
2. Amend the policies that are a barrier to privacy, where legislation change is not required.
3. Amend FOIPPA to reflect today's information management needs as it relates to the collection and sharing of personal information.
4. Create enabling legislation for eGovernment.

KEY INITIATIVES: Removing critical barriers for initiatives such as:

- HLTH - eHealth, Smart CareCard, etc.
- MCFD - Integrated Case Management
- STED - Straightforward BC (eForms)
- EDUC - Learning, Literacy and Libraries (Intellectual Property)
