## **Groups ask for CSEC testimony to be taken under oath**

Senior intelligence officers testifying at Senate committee Monday afternoon

**VANCOUVER, B.C.**—BC FIPA, writing on behalf of itself, OpenMedia.ca, and CIPPIC is asking the Senate Committee on National Security and Defence to require senior intelligence officials testifying on Monday to do so under oath.

This is in response to last night's shocking revelations that CSEC is monitoring travellers within Canada, and other instances of intelligence agencies being 'economical with the truth' when reporting on their activities.
