## Director Nomination Process

FIPA is always welcoming new ideas and people to the organization, and our board of directors is no exception. If you are interested in becoming a director, our director nomination process is set out below.

### Process for director nomination

All candidates must submit themselves to the nomination process. To do so, candidates must prepare a brief (1 page maximum) personal statement/expression of interest and send it to the Program Director and Secretary. The personal statement/expression of interest must be received at least seven (7) days prior to the date of the Annual General Meeting. This year that is Tuesday, June 12 at 5 PM Pacific Time.

Copies of all eligible personal statements/expression of interest will be provided to members as part of the Annual General Meeting package.

### Director eligibility

To be eligible for election as a director, the candidate must have been an individual member or the delegate of a group member for at least six (6) consecutive months immediately preceding the election. A director must be a member in good standing of the Society.
